HOME BANK: INDIANAPOLIS, IN

Home Bank is located in Indianapolis, Indiana, was chartered in 1890 as a mutual institution which essentially means that it is owned by its depositors. Home Bank created a gifting program where 10% of the bank's profits were to be allocated to support worthwhile projects addressing the greatest needs in the communities served.

BUILDING CHALLENGE:

After a difficult company had left this project behind, VT was there to help give the architect the guidance on what could be done with wood veneers, the selection of species of wood and most importantly, sketchface doors. Due to VT having such a wide selection of sketchface veneer designs, the

architect was able to have a creative and open mind during the selection process. The architect had a design in mind, the VT sales rep was able to provide a sample and the VT's sketchface doors were a perfect fit to all of their needs.

VT'S CONTRIBUTION:

VT provided a total of 23 flush doors including sketchface and metallic inlay doors. The sketchface doors were multi-veneered featuring Quartered Mahogany, Quarted Walnut, and Rift Red Oak (random match) with a clear finish. The flush doors featured a Quartered Walnut (random match) with Wilsonart #6277 metallic inlays with a clear finish.
