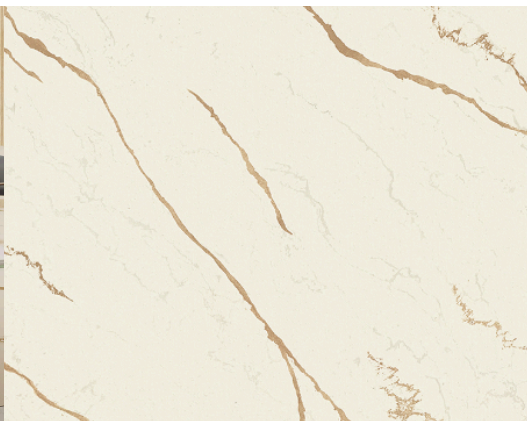
Color Drenching

Terrazzo is a design trend that has been around for years, but one that is making a comeback. We're seeing this clean and sleek trend most popular in homes featuring a contemporary design style.

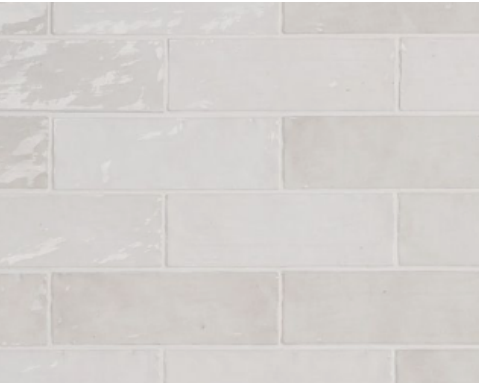
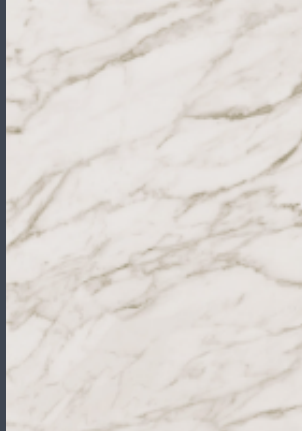




Backsplash

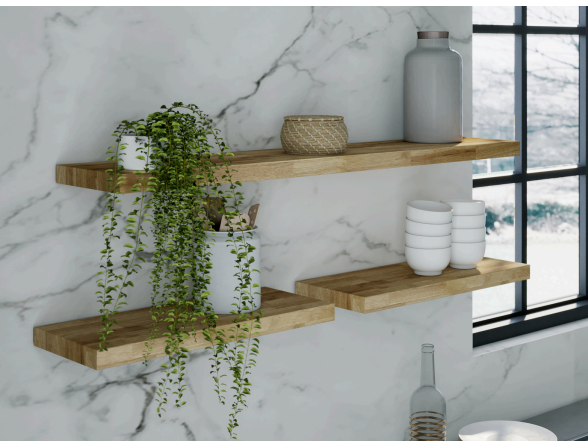
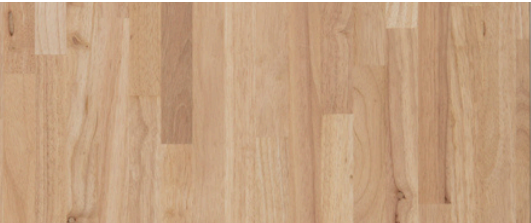




Material + Designs

Engineered hardwood remains the top choice for homeowners in 2025. The natural wood tones create a stunning look for any design style.

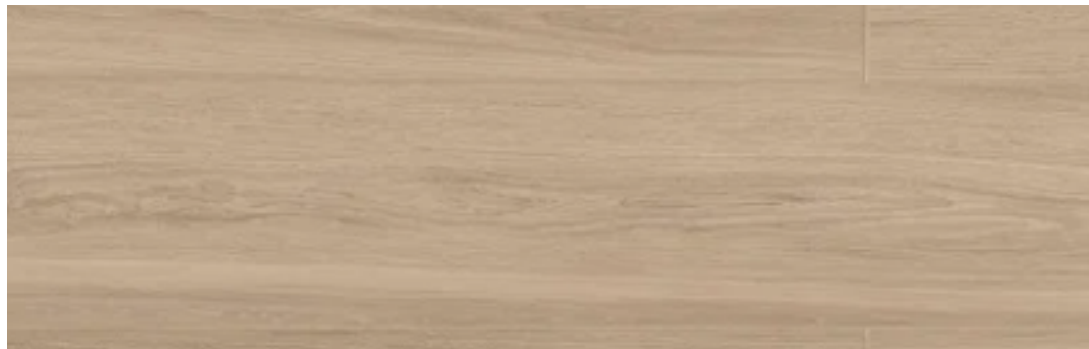


Large Natural Stone Tiles
